## **Equipment**

These are all items that you should bring along with you to college every day:

- College ID badge (to be worn at all times in college)
- Headphones, preferably wired with a 1/4 inch jack input.
- (MUSIC PERFORMANCE STUDENTS ONLY) Instruments (only required on performance days): Guitar and Bass guitar, Drumsticks, Plectrums. Drum kit, Keyboards and microphones are provided by the college

A laptop, PC or mac is advisable but not essential for your studies. During your programme, you will use software packages such as Logic Pro X. Access to a DAW of some kind would also be beneficial but not compulsory. Resources will be shared with you through Google Classroom so access to the google suite outside of college would be beneficial.

Most theoretical work will be submitted electronically, and your digital portfolios will serve as evidence of your work. Some lessons may require stationery for taking notes in class, including:

- Notepads
- Pens/pencils/highlighters
