The Level 3 Technical Occupational Entry for Cyber Security Technician (Diploma) will enable you to develop a purposeful combination of knowledge, skills and behaviours to enter employment as a cyber security technician and provides a strong foundation for you to achieve full occupational competence with further training and development in the workplace.

The course is designed to provide a clear route to employment in an occupation that is recognised and demanded by employers. It also aims to develop your ability and confidence to apply the knowledge, skills and behaviours when carrying out the functions of a cyber security technician. It will also develop your transferable skills and professional behaviours such as managing your own time to meet deadlines, managing stakeholder expectations, having a structured approach to prioritising tasks, and reviewing your own development needs to keep up to date with evolution in technologies, trends and innovations that are essential to personal effectiveness in a cyber security role.

You will also develop your knowledge and understanding of best practices relating to cyber security compliance and compliance monitoring, cyber security audit requirements, procedures and plans, importance of maintaining privacy and confidentiality of information, and the impact of a poor security culture that are important for regulatory compliance and meeting professional requirements in the cyber security sector.
